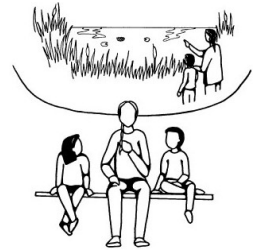

## What was our community like 150 years ago? What would you like it to look like 150 years from now?



All you will need is a paper and pencil.  
This activity is great to done with parents or grandparents

***To receive credit for this activity please take a picture and return to your teacher or call during their office hours and discuss your results.***

Sit down with an elder (mom, dad, grandparents, older sister or brother) and ask them questions so you can learn what they think the Pueblo or community looked like 150 years ago.

Here are some questions, but please think a few of your own and ask them too!

- How did people get around? Did we have cars?
- How did people communicate? Did we have electronics?
- How do you think people dressed?
- What country were we in?
- Where did we get our food and water?
- Was the Pueblo any bigger or smaller? Who was living here?
- What did the houses look like?
- What did kids do? Did kids go to school?

After you have heard answers from an elder, go to a quiet place and sit and imagine: If you were alive 150 years ago what would your community look like? Write your answers on a sheet of paper and make a drawing.

- What do you smell?
- What do you hear?
